PROPOSED ADMINISTRATIVE REORGANIZATION

Action

Transfer responsibility for administrative supervision of the following agencies from the Academic Vice President to the Executive Vice President:

- 1. Office of Admissions and Records
- 2. Office of Computer Services
- 3. Office of Institutional Research
- 4. Office of Facilities Planning (Executive Dean)

Rationale

1. Most of the agencies listed have as a common purpose the generation, dissemination and interpretation of information and data essential to the functions of decision-making on a campus-wide basis. Their close coordination by a single supervisor will enable the development of a reliable management information system of service to the entire campus. They have a sufficient degree of coherence of function, therefore, to permit effective administrative

coordination.

- 2. Experience has indicated that more effective support to the instructional programs, to research, and to administration can be achieved by a closer coordination of the functions performed by these agencies.
- 3. The change in supervisory responsibility need not, does not, and will not affect the current participation of these agencies in various administrative committees or task forces.
