# SM-S13-2, Senate Management Resolution, Suspends Senate By-Law 1.5

#### **Legislative History:**

At its meeting of April 15, 2013, the Academic Senate approved the following Senate Management Resolution presented by Senator Ng for the Executive Committee.

#### Senate Management Resolution: Suspends Senate By-Law 1.5

**Suspends Senate By-Law 1.5:** Representatives to the Academic Senate shall be nominated by a petition signed by at least ten (10) members of the faculty electorate of the appropriate election unit. The candidates shall indicate by his/her signature on the petition his/her willingness to serve if elected.

Rationale:

After polling the members of the election committee (By-law 8.1), it was discovered that gaps in communication occurred regarding the notification of openings for senators. Each of the election committee or associate deans in colleges was contacted. The only complaint received was for the College of Science. The Executive Committee, upon recommendation of the Election Committee voted to re-open the nominations for senator in the College of Science.

Resolved:

That the nomination petition process be suspended for the purposes of expediting the nomination and election process for the College of Science for the Spring 2013 General Election.

Resolved:

The proposed calendar for nominations and college elections be adopted for the College of Science election.

Resolved:

That the Election Committee (Committee on Committees) reevaluates the nomination and election announcement process such that senate and committee vacancies are clearly communicated to the electorate in each election.
