DISCUSSION ITEMS

Resolved,

That the following be added to the Standing Rules of the Senate as Rule 16:

16. The Executive Committee may place a discussion item on the Senate agenda (under New Business) at its own initiative or at the request of a policy commit-tee or at the request of any six members. A brief written statement of the topic and its current relevance shall be distributed to Senate members at or in advance of the meeting. A spokesperson shall be designated by the group requesting the discussion, and the spokesperson shall be recognized by the Chair to open the discussion. The only permissible Senate action on a discussion item at that meeting is that the discussion be carried over to a subsequent meeting or reference to committee.
