- 2. The Executive Committee discussed and selected nominees for the review committee for the AVP/Dean of International and Extended Studies.
- 3. The Executive Committee discussed **AS 1348, Sense of the Senate Resolution, Access to Electronic Information Technology for Persons with Disabilities (Final Reading).** This resolution will be presented at the January 29, 2007 Senate meeting.
- 4. President Kassing gave an update on the Greater Expectations Retreat. The Executive Committee discussed the need for Senate leadership to be involved in planning if this is an ongoing activity.
