## **Guide to Speed Mentoring**

## What is speed mentoring?

Speed mentoring is a series of short conversations about specific questions. You will meet with a limited number of mentors/mentees in a 20-minute session.

At the start and end of each speed mentoring round, a bell will ring. The mentor will move to the next table.

## Mentees should share with the mentors the following:

- Name
- Major/Degree
- · Career and/or Life Aspirations and Goals

## <u>Suggested questions that mentees can ask mentors:</u>

- · What characteristics do you look for in a new engineer?
- If you could give one piece of job hunting advice to new graduates, what would it be?
- · What was instrumental for you in landing your first professional job?
- · What is one characteristic that you believe every leader should possess?
- · What is one mistake you witness leaders making more frequently than others?
- · What is the one behavior or trait that you have seen derail more leaders' careers?
- · What advice would you give someone going into a leadership position for the first time?
- What has been your most rewarding accomplishment?
- · If you could do it all again, what would you do differently?
- · What's the best advice you can give to help plan a career rather than simply work to keep a job?
- Do you have a mentor? How have they influenced you?
- · How and where do you find inspiration?
- · As a leader, what opportunities have you chosen to participate in, and what have you turned down when it comes to being involved in the community?
- · What talents or strengths do you rely on most in your daily life as a leader?
- · What's the biggest mistake you ever made? What did you learn from it?
